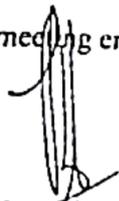
The following issues were discussed:

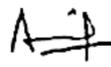
Item-1:

In light of the feedback received from the external expert who conducted the evaluation of the M.Tech. CSE 2nd Semester (Batch 2025) course "Mini Project with Seminar", and with a view to ensuring a uniform and structured evaluation mechanism for the students enrolled in this course, the Departmental Committee has unanimously resolved to prescribe the following guidelines for the undertaking and evaluation of the Mini Project with Seminar:

1. A student may opt for either a Research-based Mini Project or a Software Development-based Mini Project, in consultation with the supervisor allotted to him/her.
2. A student opting for the research-based project shall undertake a comprehensive literature review and identify relevant research gap(s) in order to formulate a clear problem statement, in consultation with the supervisor. The student shall submit a duly approved and signed synopsis outlining the proposed research work.
3. A student opting for the software development-based project shall carry out a requirement analysis for the proposed system and prepare a Software Requirements Specification (SRS) document, along with the architectural design details, in consultation with the supervisor. The same shall be submitted in the form of a synopsis clearly indicating the scope and applicability of the proposed software solution.
4. The student shall present the project synopsis before the Departmental Committee on a date notified by the Department, for review and formal approval of the proposed work.

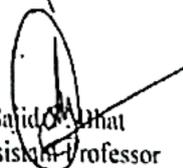
