Notice regarding conduct of RPAC I, II, III & IV

This is the for the information of all those Research scholars, who want to present their research work in RPAC I, II, III or IV scheduled on 15-09-2026 at 10:00 a.m. that they shall submit an application duly signed and recommended by their respective supervisors in the office of the undersigned by or before 9th September, 2026 along with the copies of following documents, wherever applicable: -

1. For RPAC I, submit a simple application.
2. For RPAC II, submit RPAC I certificate and proof of conference publication.
3. For RPAC III, submit RPAC I & II certificates along with proof of two conference publications.
4. For RPAC IV, submit RPAC I, II & III certificates along with proof of two conference and one Journal publications and proof of BORS registration. For Journal Publications, signed consent of the supervisor as per prescribed format be also attached, Proof of Supervisor being the corresponding author for the Journal Publication be also submitted.
5. RPAC checklist downloadable from the Departmental website.
6. Consent format for Journal publication downloadable from the Departmental website.
7. Evidence about Journal's Scopus Coverage at the time of submission of the Journal paper duly signed and recommended by the concerned Supervisor

Or

Scopus profile active link of research scholar embedded as QR code on a separate document.

However, it may be noted that a scholar is eligible for next RPAC only if his/her previous RPAC was conducted 6 months before this scheduled RPAC. Moreover, the scholars shall also submit the attendance of the preceding period duly signed and recommended by their respective supervisors along with their applications.

Further, the guidelines prescribed in the Departmental Committee meeting held on 29th December 2025 regarding RPAC presentation (copy attached) be also adhered to, which inter-alia require scholars to submit PDF and duly signed hard copies of their RPAC presentations, to office of the HOD and to limit their presentations to a maximum of 15 slides.
