



## **Notification**

It is notified for the information of all concerned that in anticipation of the approval of the competent authority, the Vice Chancellor on the recommendations of the Admission Advisory Committee has authorized the following:

1. The Reservation Policy in vogue shall be implemented for all programmes independently; however, in case percentage of unrepresented category/ies does not add up to a full seat, the fractions of such categories shall be clubbed together for the purpose of seat allocation. Seat allocation shall be made strictly on inter-se merit within clubbed /unrepresented categories, subject to the following conditions:

- Not more than one seat shall be allotted to any category whose fractional share has been clubbed.
- Where more than one seat becomes available from clubbed fractions, the next seat shall be allotted to another unrepresented category on the basis of higher merit.

### **2. Eligibility Criteria for Two-Year P.G. Programme**

Candidates must possess any one of the following qualifications:

- a. A three-year bachelor's degree under NEP-2020 or Choice-based Credit System (CBCS) with a minimum of 12 credits in the concerned subject, or
- b. A three-year bachelor's degree under semester or annual scheme (other than NEP/CBCS) with the concerned subject studied in all semesters/years.
- c. A four-year bachelor's degree with at least 12 credits in the concerned subject.

### **3. Eligibility Criteria for One-Year P.G. Programme**

Candidates must possess:

- a. A four-year Bachelor's Degree (honors or research mode) under NEP-2020 with a minimum of 20 credits in the concerned subject.
- b. Candidates with Four-Year Bachelor's Degree (Including B.E., B.Tech):  
A four-year Bachelor's degree, including B.E./B.Tech., in Honours or Research mode, with a minimum of 160 credits (under a credit-based system), shall be eligible to apply for admission, provided they have obtained at least 20 credits in the concerned subject.

### **4. Entrance Examination Syllabus for Two-Year Masters Programme (Under NEP-2020):**

- a. The syllabus consists of 12 units covering six semesters of the 3-year undergraduate programme.
- b. From each unit, there shall be 5 multiple-choice questions (MCQs).

### **5. Entrance Examination Syllabus for One-Year Master's Programme**

- a. The syllabus shall comprise 16 units, covering eight semesters of the four-year undergraduate programme.
- b. From each unit, there shall be 5 multiple-choice questions (MCQs).



**6. Structure of Entrance Question Paper:**

The Entrance Examination shall consist of the following papers:

a. **Main Paper:**

- Sixty (60) MCQs of 60 marks drawn from the 12-unit syllabus of the three-year undergraduate programme.
- This paper shall be common for candidates seeking admission to both two-year and one-year Master's programmes, unless otherwise specified.

b. **Additional Paper for one-year PG Programme aspirants:**

- Twenty (20) MCQs of 20 marks drawn from the last four units (Units 13 to 16) of the fourth year of the undergraduate programme.
- This paper shall be exclusively applicable to candidates seeking admission to one-year Master's programmes.

**7. Special provision for two-year programmes with open eligibility**

Notwithstanding anything contained above, in programmes where two-year Master's programmes have open eligibility, the entrance test examination for the two-year programme shall be of a general nature and not subject-specific.

Accordingly:



- The entrance paper for the two-year programme shall be based on a general syllabus as notified.
- The entrance paper for the one-year programme shall be subject-specific.
- The question papers for two-year and one-year programmes in such cases shall be different.

**8. Lateral Entry / Admission Against Vacant Seats**

Admission against available vacancies shall be permitted in **five-year Integrated Programmes** at:

- **7th Semester** for admission to **two-year Master's programmes**, and
- **9th Semester** for admission to **one-year Master's programmes**,

except in programmes where **NEP-2020 has not been implemented**, such as **B.A. LL.B. etc.**
