It is notified for the information of all concerned that the Vice-Chancellor in anticipation of the approval of Competent Body has approved the recommendations of the committee constituted regarding following amendments/additions in the Statutes governing Four Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP) under NEP-2020:

<i>Existing Statute 4.5</i>	<i>Addition of clause(i) to Statute 4.5</i>
<i>Every student shall also have to opt for one common Ability Enhancement Course (AEC) of 3 credits in each of the 1st three semesters comprising Communication Skills, English Language and any one of the Modern Indian Languages.</i>	<i>A student interested in change of the chosen Modern Indian Language Course shall be allowed to do so after applying with recommendation of the HoI / Principal of his/her institution for the purpose.</i>

<i>Existing Statute-4.8</i>	<i>Addition of clause(i) to Statute 4.8</i>
<i>The students choosing one Major and one Minor Subject shall have a flexibility of swapping the Major and Minor Subjects in 3rd Semester, subject to availability in the institution concerned and eligibility (to be determined by the institution). However, if a student selects a Minor Subject, not being offered as a Major, he/she shall not have this flexibility.</i>	<i>The two subjects to be chosen either as two Majors (Dual Major) or as a Major and a Minor (Single Major) have, necessarily, to be selected from the same stream, as reflected in Regulation-1.</i>

Statute 4.9	Addition of clause(i) to Statute 4.9
<p>Change of one subject in 3rd semester shall be allowed/permitted on the recommendations of the principal of the college, subject to the condition that the student concerned shall be required to pass/qualify the said paper/subject of the 1st and 2nd semester, before exit from the programme at any level /stage.</p>	<p>In case the chosen subject after change is a Laboratory Oriented one, the college shall also certify that facility for arranging the Practicals of the new subject for the earlier semesters shall be arranged by the institution during the pursuit of higher semesters of the programme so that the university arranges for the practical examination for the pending courses.</p> <p>Similar mechanism be followed in case a student enrolls for any additional subject with a practical component, during or after completing the UG programme.</p>

Statute-20(2):	Addition of proviso to Statute -20(2)
<p>On successful completion of/exit from a programme as per the statutes, a Certificate/Diploma/Degree shall be awarded to a candidate, and a Transcript indicating the Grade Performance of the candidate from 1st to the last semester shall be issued.</p> <p>Provided that where a candidate seeks exit, a Transcript indicating the Grade Performance from 1st semester to exit shall also be issued.</p>	<p>On successful completion of/exit from a programme as per the statutes, a Certificate/Diploma/Degree shall be awarded to a candidate, and a Transcript indicating the Grade Performance of the candidate from 1st to the last semester shall be issued.</p> <p>Provided that where a candidate seeks exit, a Transcript indicating the Grade Performance from 1st semester to exit shall also be issued.</p> <p>Provided that where a candidate does not seek exit from the programme but applies for a transcript at any stage, a Transcript indicating the Grade Performance in all the completed semesters shall also be issued. However, for issuance of such a transcript the candidate shall have to deposit the fee as prescribed by the University for the purpose. The transcript shall indicate a foot note as under:</p> <p><i>"This transcript is issued on the request of the student for the sole purpose of enabling him/her to apply forThe student has not exercised the option of exit and continues to remain on rolls on the date of issuance of this transcript to complete the academic programme under reference."</i></p>



Note: 1*. In case there is any inevitable overlapping of courses in major / minor or dual major subjects, the competent authority may direct such courses to be treated as mutually exclusive.

2. Credit Distribution for Each Course shall be as under:

I. Major/Minor:

- i. First three Semesters: 4 + 2 Credits each
ii. 4th to 8th Semester: 4 + 2 Credits each

II. CT-1 (Major/ Minor): 3+1 Credits each

III. CT-2 & CT-3 (Major): 4 + 2 Credits each

3. Multi-Disciplinary (MDC): 3 Credits each

4. Ability Enhancement (AEC): 3 Credits each

5. Value Added (VAC): 2 Credits each

6. Skill Enhancement (SEC): 2+2 Credits each
