The following issues were discussed:

Item-I:

The Departmental Committee deliberated on the space requirements of the Department which is presently offering three academic programmes—MCA, M. Tech (CSE), and FYIMP (DS & AI). In view of the joining of the upcoming third batch (batch 2026) of students for the FYIMP (DS & AI) programme, the Departmental Committee noted the acute shortage of physical space in terms of classrooms & labs required to accommodate these students within the department. The Departmental Committee also noted that the existing infrastructural constraints may lead to negative perception among students, if the issue is not addressed at an earliest.
