The following issues were discussed: -

Item-I

In light of communication via e-file No. KU-CMS-2026-147 dated: 04-06-2026 & the letter vide No. F(Clar-B-Lev)Acad/KU/26 dated: 02-06-2026 addressed to Head of the Department and in continuation to resolution adopted at Item-I of the Departmental Committee meeting held on 05-05-2026 regarding equivalence/acceptability of B-level (DOEACC/NIELIT) qualification for the purpose of eligibility to the post of Assistant Registrar in the University of Kashmir, the Departmental Committee again reviewed the application and noted the following:

- DOEACC O level exam is pursued after 10+2 or any Diploma (Govt. Recognized) of a minimum of 1-year duration after 10th class/ITI certificate (one year) after class 10, followed in each case *(for students from institutes conducting accredited courses)*.

For Students at large (Direct Applicants):

10+2 or any diploma (Govt. Recognized) of a minimum of 1-year duration after 10th class/ITI certificate (one year) after class 10, followed in each case or

A pass in the NCVT-DP&CS (Data preparation & Computer Software) Examination conducted by DGE&T (Govt. of India) or

Any graduate from recognized University/Institute is eligible to register at "O" level without any experience. Further "A" level exam is pursued after qualifying "O" level exam & "B" level exam is pursued after qualifying "A" level exam.

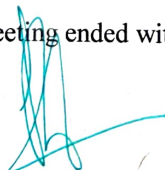
- The minimum duration of O level course is 1 year, A level is 1 year & B level is 2 year.
- Notification No.'s 54, 49 & 43 attached with the application were not found on the e-gazette web portal, Govt. of India (egazette.gov.in), upon searching on the basis of date of issuance of notification.

Keeping in view these observations, the Departmental Committee unanimously noted that the claim of the applicant that MHRD notification to the effect that "B level computer exam is recognized for purpose of the employment under Central Government where MCA is the desired qualification" could not be verified from the record available on e-gazette or any central govt. institute.

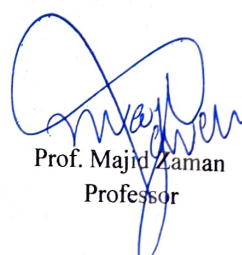
Further, even if the Notification referred to is considered valid, its applicability is restricted in scope for employment in central government only.

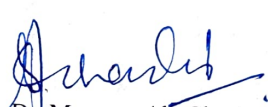

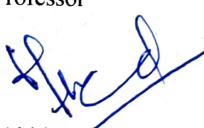

At the outset the Dean Academic Affairs welcomed the members of the Standing Committee of Academic Council (SCAC) which has been recently reconstituted on completion of the tenure by the earlier SCAC where after he requested the Vice Chancellor for his introductory remarks. The Vice Chancellor in his introductory remarks while welcoming the new members of the SCAC maintained that given the large constitution of the Academic Council it is imperative for us to address important issues for promoting quality education. He said many initiatives have been taken in this direction. The Vice chancellor apprised the members that the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) had been introduced to improve the standards further and also to bring these in tune with the contemporary requirements. Stressing upon the maintenance of quality he expressed his hope that the present body would contribute significantly and help the University to promote quality culture and tread successfully on the path of excellence. Thereafter the main agenda was taken up for discussion.

Item

- No.01 Confirmation of the minutes (already circulated) of the last meeting of the Standing Committee of Academic Council held on 22-02-2014.

Resolved that the minutes (already circulated) of the last meeting of the Standing Committee of Academic Council held on 22-02-2014 be confirmed.

Considered the:-

- I. Amendment in eligibility criteria for admission to Post-graduate Diploma course in Spoken English in the Department of English.
- II. Change of nomenclature of the P.G Diploma course in Spoken English of nine months duration to Diploma in Spoken English of six months duration.

Resolved that the matter be referred to the following Committee for examining the issue in detail:

- i. Dean Academic Affairs
- ii. Dean Faculty of Law
- iii. Dean Faculty of Arts
- iv. Head of the department concerned
- v. Controller of Examinations
- vi. Assistant Registrar Academic

It was further resolved that the Committee shall review all the Diploma courses and come up with a comprehensive proposal regarding continuation of these courses/ or otherwise and prepare a uniform set of statutes for all the Diploma courses for consideration by the SCAC.

- No.07 Considered the recommendations of the sub-committee constituted to examine the issue regarding the grant of equivalence to B. Level course of DOEACC Centre Sgr. to the MCA of this University.

Resolved that since the B. level course fails to fulfill the criterion which, inter-alia includes eligibility for admission and duration of the course laid down by the University for grant of Equivalence, B. Level course of DOEACC Centre/NIELT Srinagar be not treated as equivalent to the MCA course/degree of this University.

Item

- No.08 Considered the proposal of the Controller of Examinations for prescription of same examination fee for the students appearing in the M.A Examination through Distance Education or as private candidates as is being charged from the candidates pursuing such a course through regular mode.

Resolved that all the private/distance mode candidates who appear for two semester examinations together annually be charged examination fee annually for two semesters together at the time of submission of examination forms as is being charged from the candidates pursuing such a course through regular mode.
